

Trafostation 61-Festival

August 11th-13th, 2017, Frechen-Grefrath

2017 marks the seventh round of the Trafostation 61-Festival: 20 nationally and internationally renowned bands as well as newcomers will enter the open air stage from August 11th - 13th. On the outskirts of the city in a picturesque natural setting, visitors will enjoy all types of rock: metal, psychedelic, stoner, progressive, punk, blues and funk.

Sponsored by the non-profit association Kulturtrafo Frechen, the three-day festival follows the motto "From Friends For Friends". It offers an oasis of music and vitality, familiar flair and a relaxed atmosphere in the midst of commercially established events. In addition to the finest musical entertainment, there will be culinary delights from all over the world, local beer and an open-grill area.

The Trafostation 61 site in Frechen-Grefrath is located south-west of Cologne and can be reached by tram and bus.
